AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CLOSING A COUNTY ROAD LOCATED ON JACKSON
BRANCH COUNTY ROAD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL
COURT OF THE COUNTY OF PERRY,
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY

SECTION I.

The hereinafter described road located on Jackson Branch County
Road, in Perry County, Kentucky, shall be discontinued pursuant to the
provisions of KRS 178.070, and more specifically described as follows:

1.13 miles West of Delphia Post Office, along Kentucky Highway
463 and 1.32 miles East of the Perry/Letcher County Line along
Kentucky Highway 463. Latitude 37 01' 43", Longitude 83 04' 00".

The road is a gravel road, approximately 18 - 20 feet in width
and travels in a Northeastern direction up Jackson Branch
for a distance of approximately .4 tenths of a mile.

SECTION II.


County Road Foreman shall cause notice of this discontinuance to be
published pursuant to KRS 178.050 and shall in addition cause notice to
be posted in the vicinity of the road pursuant to KRS 178.070.

SECTION III.

Subsequent to the posting of the notice as set forth in the
preceeding paragraph, Herman Hall and Freddie Combs shall be
appointed as viewers, who, together with the road foreman, shall view
the road and report in writing what inconvenience would result in the
discontinuance.

SECTION IV.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its
adoption and approval as provided by law.
