

**AMENDMENT TO
ORDINANCE CREATING A NON-TAXING SOLID WASTE
DISTRICT AND PASSED BY THE PERRY COUNTY FISCAL
COURT ON JUNE 30, 1998**

Section V of said ordinance shall be amended to read as follows:
Kentucky Solid Waste Management District shall have the following powers set forth in
KRS 109.041;

1. May plan, initiate, acquire, construct, maintain, own and hold permits for solid waste management facilities, provided that construction of any proposed solid waste management facility shall be subject to the approval of the fiscal court of the county within which said proposed solid waste management facility is to be constructed.
2. Pursue funding necessary to build a regional solid waste management facility.
3. Enter into contracts or leases with private parties for design, construction, or operation of a publicly-owned solid waste management facility.
4. Adopt administrative regulations with respect thereto in accordance with this chapter.
5. Condemn land as necessary for the construction of solid waste management facilities pursuant to the Eminent Domain Act of Kentucky and to exercise the police power in respect thereto is confirmed.
6. Contract with neighboring counties/cities to expand the regional solid waste management area.
